A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND PRESENTATION OF SPECIFIC AWARDS TO ALL FIRE DISTRICT MEMBERS FOR DEDICATED SERVICE PERFORMED FOR THE FIRE DISTRICT AT AN ANNUAL PROGRAM

- WHEREAS** The Board of Commissioners recognizes the benefit to the Fire District of longevity in years-of-service by its employees; and
- WHEREAS** The Board further recognizes the countless hours of dedication and service that its employees donate during their tenure with the Fire District; and
- WHEREAS** The Board has determined it to be worthwhile and expedient to publicly recognize and reward its members for longevity and service; and
- WHEREAS** Washington State Law provides in part that a local governmental body may provide a nominal reward to its members in recognition for their services rendered;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FIRE DISTRICT #4, SNOHOMISH COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON THAT:

1. The Board of Fire Commissioners may host an Annual Fire District Awards Program each year to present Service Awards and Special Recognition Awards to Fire District employees, volunteers, and citizens.
2. The Fire District shall acquire the Service Awards and Special Recognitions from its Operating Budget.
3. No Service Award shall exceed the amount in policy and approved by the Board of Commissioners, must be fire service-related, and must state the reason for the award.
4. The selection of awards and administration of this resolution will be done by policy.
5. **IT IS ALSO HEREBY RESOLVED** that Resolution #380 of June 20, 2005 is repealed.
