A RESOLUTION TO MOVE THE TRAINING CENTER FUNDS INTO THE GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS: Snohomish County Fire District #4 is the provider of Fire and Emergency Medical

Services within a jurisdiction as established by law; and

WHEREAS: The District collects tax revenue that must be distributed based on the best

business practices available to fund the operation of the District as directed by

the Board of Fire Commissioners; and

WHEREAS: The District annually plans a budget where designated revenues can be segregated, tracked,

budgeted, and accounted for; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Commissioners of Fire District #4 has deemed it prudent to consolidate

managerial funds as allowed by Washington State Law; and

WHEREAS: The Board of Commissioners of Fire District #4 has the ability to segregate and account for

these funds within the General Fund (F70).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF FIRE DISTRICT #4, COUNTY OF SNOHOMISH, STATE OF WASHINGTON THAT:

- 1. Resolution 486 is hereby repealed.
- 2. The F-76 Training Center Fund will be closed by February 2024 and the fund balances as adopted by policy for General Reserves and Training Center, are maintained as the majority of the Board Directs through policy, resolution or other legal action.
- 3. The Fire Chief and/or Finance Chief will report on the Training Center funding during normal budget presentations, and those funds will be accounted for separately within the General Fund.
- 4. The Fire Chief is authorized to take all necessary actions to close fund F-76 prior to the specified date.
